



School Uniform Policy for 2018-2019

Bottoms

- Khakis or navy blue. NO DENIM
- Bermuda shorts, capris, pants, skirts, skorts
- Any of the above items can be purchased anywhere...as long as they are khakis or navy blue
- Thick/sport leggings/jeggings will be allowed for girls...khakis or navy blue (Capri or Bermuda length)

TOPS

- Wear the current King of Kings polos
- Purchase new polos, red or white, through our current vendor with current logo
Children: \$10.95 Adult: \$14.50
- If warmer attire is needed, an option would be to purchase solid white or black thermal undershirts
- If warmer attire is needed, purchase a red or black sweatshirt through our current vendor with logo...no hood

Children: \$14.85 Adult: \$15.65

- If warmer attire is needed, purchase a red or black zip-up sweatshirt through our current vendor, with logo...hood allowed

Children: \$27.00 Adult: \$30.00

SAMPLES

LAST SCHOOL DAY OF EACH MONTH

On the last school day of each month, students will be allowed to wear what they want as long as it falls into the guidelines set forth in the Parent/Student handbook titled **Dress Code:**

7.0 The following dress policy has been adopted for students at King of Kings Lutheran School. Here are several helpful guidelines when deciding what to wear to school:

- **Shorts/skirt length** should be at or below the halfway point of child's thigh; or when standing, if fingertips go beyond the short/skirt line, then they might be too short.
- **Midriffs** should be visible. You can test this by holding both hands up over your head. If your belly shows, the top is too short.
- **Our young ladies need to be sure that their chests are covered.** If a person can stand directly in front of a young lady, and see cleavage, they are not properly covered.
- **Our young men need to keep their pants up around their waist, preferably with a belt.** If a person can see underwear, the pants are not properly secured.
- Please be mindful of **wording on graphic tees/shirts**. It should be God pleasing. Ask the question, "Would Jesus wear it?"
- **Muscle shirts/tank tops** will not be allowed. They allow too much skin to be shown.
- For safety reasons, **no flip-flops**.
- **No tops with spaghetti straps.**
