



WSDOT Transportation Demand Management Executive Board

The purpose of the Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Executive Board is to improve the effectiveness of transportation facilities and services through near-term, multimodal investments. This board will increase the movement of people, goods and services to support economic vitality and a clean, healthy environment.

The board is chaired by WSDOT Secretary Roger Millar.

The board will:

- Influence WSDOT, regional and local TDM investments and policies
- Pursue additional TDM revenue
- Educate, advocate and advance smart, efficient, cost-effective transportation investments
- Establish a state TDM vision, targets, priorities
- Empower other partners to support board's goals

The board is scheduled to meet quarterly for 90 minutes in Olympia and meet annually with the Governor.

The TDM Executive Board is supported by a sixteen member TDM Technical Committee comprised of experts from throughout the state and WSDOT staff.

Following direction from the board's first meeting on February 7, 2019, the TDM Technical Committee and WSDOT staff will draft a 2019 work plan and identify TDM policies that will produce tangible results within a year.

This draft will be presented to the board for discussion and approval.
